

The Group (Ramada, BPS and Storax) is now world leader in cold storage solutions.






# MOBILE RACKING

Storage in which static pallet racking is installed on electrically powered bases that move on rails fitted in the floor.

Only needs a single operating aisle. The bases are moved by the operator to gain access to the required stock location.


Ideal solution for cold stores.








Floor preparation

Automated warehouses operate using mechanised storage and retrival systems.


Both of these solutions usally involve a high level of automation and computerised stock management systems.


### CLAD RACK BUILDINGS AUTOMATED WAREHOUSES













## DYNAMIC RACKING

Gravity-fed storage system. Pallets are loaded at the onload end of the lanes and travel along rollers under the force of gravity to the offload face.

Operating space is only needed in the on load and offload areas.

Provides storage according to FIFO sustem.

The structure is formed by a pallet racking framework supporting conveyor beds is each lane.










Gravity-fed system in which all pallets are stored and retrieved from the same face.

Provides storage according to Lifo System.


Created by adapting normal pallet racking to accommodate telescopic, nesting pallet trolleys.


















System designed for static or dynamic storage of textile clothing and its manual or automatic handling.

In this solution there can be various floor levels with the clothing transported between floors by means of motorised conveyors.








Handling detail

Materials are stored in a drawer type system that ensures rapid access.


Top level of rack provides additional static storage.

Maximum load per drawer of 1000 Kg.




